

Voc. Act. Proposal for Construction Project at MBC

Synopsis and Vision: This is a project to bring professional and experienced people together with apprentice students for a semi classroom learning experience. All projects are planned and organized with the approval of a job foreman and church leadership.

Over the next few weeks this Vocational Activity will be planned and coordinated with the purpose to teach many entry level principles to young people by mature Christians. The main priority is for someone to be a productive employee with skills in tool operation and safety.

Steps:

1. Address and promote activity and project at Men's Breakfast on June 19th
2. Get men to sign up for a task that includes working with a student. (Jim)
3. Develop contacts – both youth and experienced mentors from churches in the area.
4. Establish task order and time schedule.
5. Appoint foreman to oversee and monitor all segments of job.
6. Assign specific on the job task to mentors.
7. Create a work ethics manual for on the job character building. (Rense)
8. Assign team appointments around availability of students and mentors
9. Record each segment of the activities for future assessment and feedback. (Rense with camera)
10. Schedule a form of recognition and written resume for each student. (graduation ceremony)
 - a. Signed document for students resume.
 - b. T-shirt and tool belt
 - c. Testimonies of experiences from both mentor and student
